- ✓ The goal of PELARGOS NATURA is to be a catalyst of as many as possible actions, for the benefit of the unique Greek Wildlife




























THE PROTECTION OF THE MONK SEAL IN GREECE

The Mediterranean Monk Seal is included in the "Red Book of Endangered Animals in Greece". European and Greek legislation forbids the killing, wounding, trapping or even disturbing of these extremely rare animals.

Since 1992, efforts by both the Hellenic State and a dedicated scientific organization, are underway to establish a network of protected marine areas in our country, which will eventually secure the future of both the Mediterranean Monk Seal and the existing fish stocks.





MOm: The Environmental Organization for the Protection of the Monk Seal in Greece

MOm/Hellenic Society for the Study and Protection of the Mediterranean Monk Seal is a greek, Non Government Environmental Organization dedicated to the protection of the Mediterranean Monk Seal in Greece. MOm was founded in 1988 and is a member of IUCN (International Union for the Conservation of Nature). The activities of MOm include:

- Scientific research,
- Rescue and rehabilitation of sick, wounded or orphan Seals,
- · Protection and efficient management of critical habitats for the species,
- Dissemination of information and sensitization of the general public
