Why the hoopoe?



The situation in the Czech Republic (past and present)

- steep decline in the past (1950s and 1960s), related to agricultural practices (intensification, chemicals) and habitat loss
- currently stable (approx. 100 pairs)
- CR



Habitat preference and biology of the hoopoe



- open landscape (pastures, meadows)
- grown trees cavities
- short-stemmed grass/meadows with invertebrates
- foraging and nesting sites close



Threats



Habitat alternations and loss

undesired succession of meadows –
the lack of traditional agricultural
techniques (extensive pastures /
small scale farming)

Nesting sites

the lack of nesting cavities



The hoopoe's role in the project: goal vs. tool



Why the hoopoe (again)?

a charismatic and well-known bird species

=> very positively perceived by the public

=> support and
 cooperation (flagship)

- shared habitat with MANY other threatened species of animals and plants (umbrella species)
- the same for habitat locally threatened

not only a goal but also a tool
